The University provides specific amount as grant-in-aid for repayment of amount of interest on the education loan to the eligible students under this scheme.  The student who has taken education loan from the bank for his / her regular studies of the UG/PG course of health sciences from the affiliated College / recognized Institute of the University may apply under the said scheme. The University provides specific amount as grant-in-aid for educational expenses to the eligible, needy and poor female students under this scheme.  The female student prosecuting her regular studies of the UG/PG course of health sciences from the affiliated College / recognized Institute of the

5	<p>What is “Sanjeevani Student Security Scheme”?</p>	<p>The University is providing financial aid to the regular students of the affiliated Colleges / recognized Institutes of the University during prosecution of his / her studies.</p> <p>Under this scheme, after receipt of complete proposal due to following incidence the financial aid of amount shown against each incidence is being admissible:</p> <p>i. In case of death (either due to accident / natural calamity / illness / natural) of regular student Rs. 2,00,000/- is admissible to the parents of the deceased student.</p> <p>ii. Permanent Disability of any two limbs, Rs. 2,00,000/- is admissible.</p> <p>iii. Permanent Disability of any one limb, Rs. 1,00,000/- is admissible.</p> <p>iv. For surgery / treatment of major diseases (for e.g. surgery of brain, heart, lever, lungs, cancer, any organ transplantation), Actual amount of admissible bill of treatment or Rs. 50,000/- whichever is less is admissible.</p> <p>v. For bone fracture or minor surgery, actual amount of admissible bill of treatment or Rs. 10,000/- whichever is less is being admissible.</p> <p>vi. For dialysis, Rs.2000/- per dialysis is being admissible. (Maximum 04 dialysis per month).</p>

		<p>viii.
